## Technical reasons and scientific justifications why additional resources are needed

We are pursuing the effect of heavy rain on the development of sea storms. This requires a large number of tests where we explore different rain dependent physics and compare the results with a standard run (i.e. with the present set-up operational at ECMWF).

To save units, rather than one month test, (as we did last year), we focus on single ten day forecasts, each costing about 150000 units.

The results of our present three runs have clearly indicate where the attention needs to be focused (i.e. on modification of the source function). We expect that at least two more experiments are required to frame well the situation. Together with 100K units we are presently left with, we ask for 200K more units to complete our research.
